Ohio Mourns Death of Past Supreme Governor (2001) H. Ray Lewis

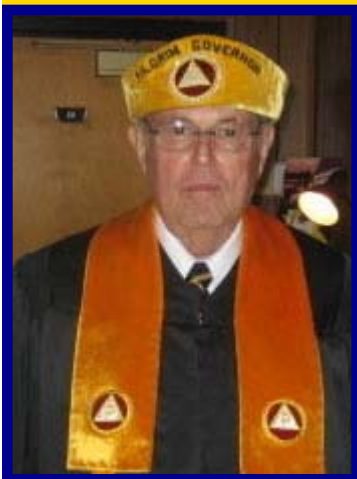


Harold Ray Lewis (aged 78) passed away on Wednesday, January 6, 2010 while at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Ray dedicated the better part of his life to the Loyal Order of Moose, starting in July of 1956 when he was enrolled as a member of Ann Arbor, Michigan, Moose Lodge 1253. He immediately became an active volunteer, serving through all the elective chairs and serving on several of the various committees of his Lodge.

Ray joined the Moose Legion in 1960, received the Moose Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1962, the same year as he became a Past Governor of Ann Arbor Moose Lodge 1253. Ray also served his Lodge as Administrator/Club Manager from 1972 to 1988 and received the highest degree of the Order, the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1972 in the House of God at Mooseheart, Illinois.

Ray served the Michigan Moose Association as their President in 1970-1971 and as their Secretary for ten years. For several years, Ray served the Loyal Order of Moose as Deputy Supreme Governor and on the Community Service, Appeals, and Credentials committees. In 1982, Ray was appointed to the Moosehaven Board of Governors, where he served until his election to the Supreme Council in 1987.



Ray relinquished his seat on the Supreme Council in 1988 to serve the Membership Department at Mooseheart as Michigan's State Director, a position he held until 1996, when he moved to South Carolina to serve as Regional Manager for South and North Carolina. Ray also served as Assistant Director (and later returning to Michigan as Regional Director) for the Membership Department until 2005.

In May, 2006, Ray was appointed member of the Pilgrim Council for the LOOM and served as Pilgrim Governor 2007-2008.

A member of the 500 Division of the 25 Club, Ray has sponsored 556 members into the Order. For his love, service and dedication to the fraternity, Ray was honored in 2001 with a conferral as Past Supreme Governor.
