## Spreads Christmas Message In A Significant Way!

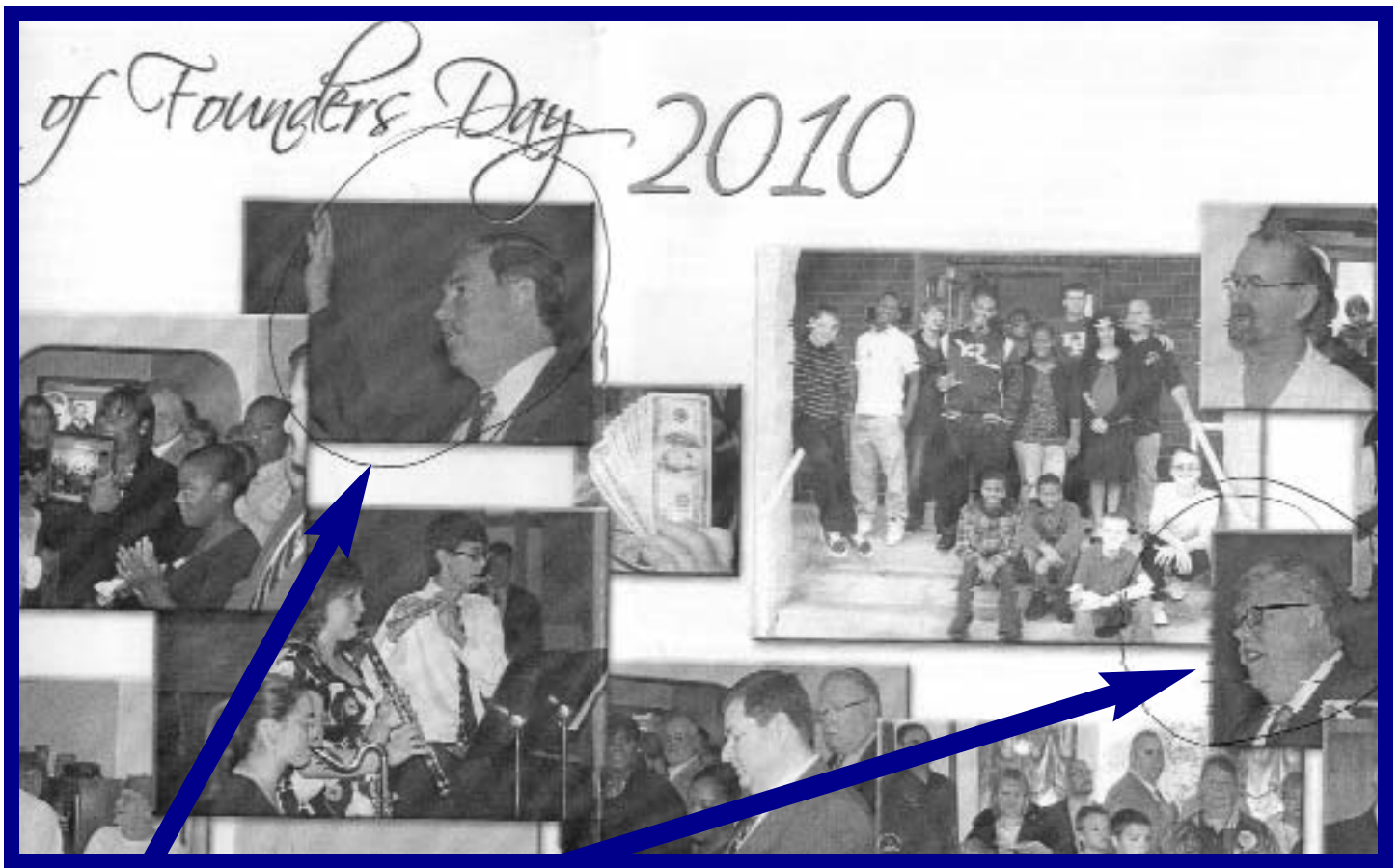
Working with the WOTM Chapter 1427, the Lodge is able to contribute substantially for their food pantry for the needy.

drove to the police station to report her mistake.

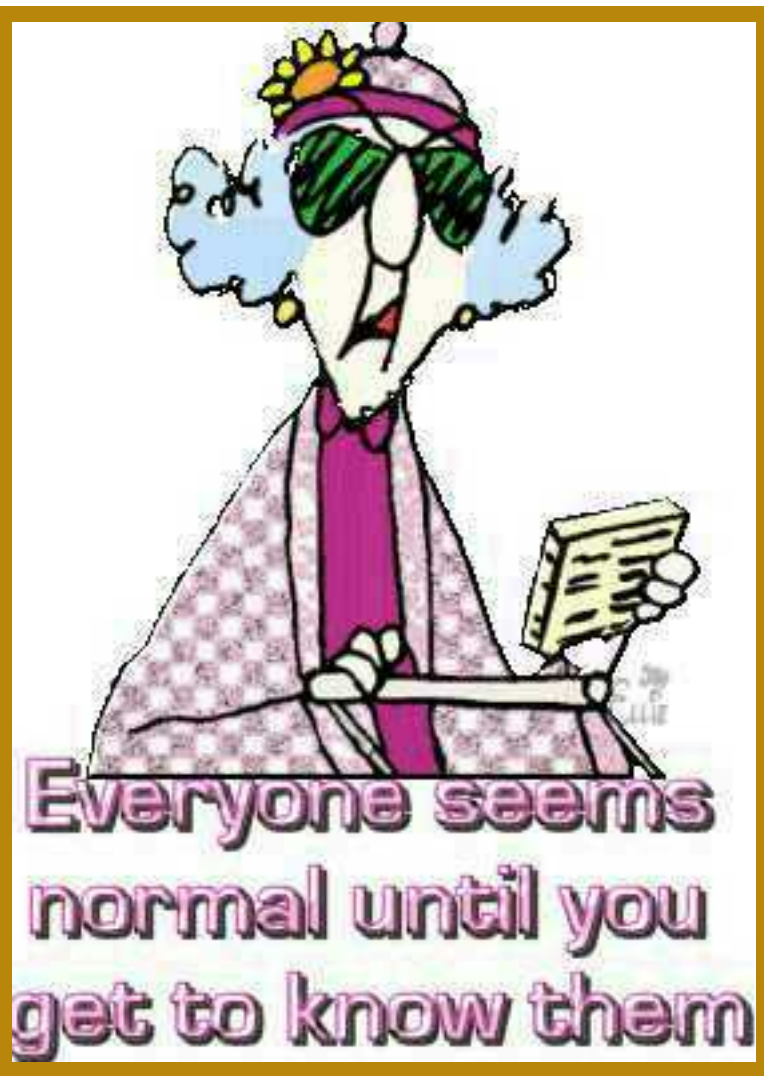
The sergeant to whom she told the story couldn't stop laughing.
