99 Mooseheart Students Experience “The Goulden Touch” In Holiday Shopping Spree At St. Charles Target Store



There wasn't any mad dashing through the aisles of St. Charles' Super Target store as 99 Mooseheart children embarked on a Christmas shopping spree. (That could be explained, in part, from some firm instructions from the adults in their lives, to not go madly dashing through the store.)

But looking into the elementary and middle school students' eyes gave away the inner thrill of holiday shopping as they began a two-hour spree made possible by Chicago Bears place-kicker Robbie Gould and his "The Goulden Touch" foundation.

"I'm excited to get the opportunity to work with Mooseheart," Gould said. "It's awesome to have the kids come and have a lot of fun today. It's fun to put a smile on a kid's face, but it brings a lot of cheer to myself and everyone involved with The Goulden Touch."

The amount involved was pretty staggering. A total of \$13,200 was available, thanks to

contributions by The Goulden Touch, the Chicago Bears' "Bears Care" charitable organization. Target and a personal donation made by Gould himself. This meant each of Mooseheart's elementary and middle school students was allowed to spend a bit over \$120.
