RECIPE

This recipe is from a friend of mine. She made it for a dinner we went to and it is great, old country cooking.

1 large head lettuce	1/2 cup pecans
2 cups shredded cheddar cheese	1/2 cup sauted sliced almonds
1/2 cup chopped red bell peppers	1 cup craisins
1 cup honey roasted sesame sticks	1/4 cup raisins
1 cup broccoli	1/4 cup onion (optional)

DRESSING

1 cup sugar	1 tsp salt
1/2 cup oil	1/2 tsp pepper
1/3 cup vinegar	1 tablespoon mustard
1/4 cup water	2 tablespoons mayonnaise

In a large bowl, combine all salad ingredients. Combine dressing ingredients and mix well. Just before serving, pour over salad and toss. May not need all of the dressing.
