## Straight from the **ADMIN'**

I am happy to announce that Defiance Lodge 2094 was awarded the distinction of being named 2018 Ohio Lodge of the Year at the OSMA 90th Convention in Independence, Ohio. After an absence of nearly a decade, the Ohio State Moose Association reintroduced the Ohio Buckeye Awards program at the convention. The event was well attended and Defiance walked away with 5 shining-star trophies. The five categories were Moose Charities Lodge of Year, Division 2 Administrator of the Year, Overall Administrator of the Year, Division 2 Lodge of the Year, and the Overall Lodge of the Year. I think this proves that our Lodge is moving in the right direction. We are truly Moose on a Mission.

On Monday, July 23, at our regular Lodge meeting, the membership voted and approved the construction of a new 800 square foot addition to the front of our current building, as well as the replacement of ceiling tile and carpet in our social quarters and dance hall. The approved motion set a maximum expenditure limit of \$400,000 for the project. Unfortunately, final costs provided by the general contractor, Mel Lanzer Company, have exceeded the limit set by our voting members. The contractor is reviewing the specs, and, if the numbers do come in within our budget, expect to see construction begin in the fall and continue through the winter. When the drawings are completed, a set will be provided for your inspection in the social quarters.

Like always, there is mucho-mucho happening at our lodge. Along with our party for the kids on Sunday, October 28, look for a big

Halloween Adult Costume Party on Saturday, October 27th. House favorite, Copper Creek Road will provide the dance music, and the prizes for best costumes are going to be huge. When you add activities like Pizza and Bingo, Fish Frys, Steak Grills, WOTM home-style dinners, Moose Family Picnic, and many of our favorite bands performing in September and October, it's easy to see that your Moose Lodge is still the place to be. And, there is no let-up in activities in November and December either.
